There are a number of ways that residents are kept informed about matters relevant to them.

- a) this website
- b) a distribution list of residents who have given permission in writing that the Clerk to SACC can send them information of interest. Should a resident wish to be included on this list, then s/he should let the Clerk know by email. Similarly, the Clerk should be informed should a name need to be removed or changed. It is usual for information to be sent BCC so that email addresses are kept confidential.
- c) The notice boards. As space is at a premium, postings on the St Arvans Community Council Notice Boards on Devauden Road and at the entrance to Laurel Park are limited to A5 size and to Charity/not for profit material. Both notice boards are currently maintained by the Chair to whom copy may be emailed or hard copies (A5) made available.
- d) There is an advertisment board in Jean's Shop where for a small fee, you can advertise your needs and skills.
- e) Fiveways, the parish magazine, is an excellent source of information and covers the five villages in the parish St Arvans, Devauden, Itton, Kilgwrrwg and Penterry. It is available by subscription or can be purchased from Jean's Shop.
