

There are a number of ways that residents are kept informed about matters relevant to them.

- a) this website
- b) a distribution list of residents who have given permission in writing that the Clerk to SACC can send them information of interest. Should a resident wish to be included on this list, then s/he should let the Clerk know by email. Similarly, the Clerk should be informed should a name need to be removed or changed. It is usual for information to be sent BCC so that email addresses are kept confidential.
- c) The notice boards. As space is at a premium, postings on the St Arvans Community Council Notice Boards on Devauden Road and at the entrance to Laurel Park are limited to A5 size and to Charity/not for profit material. Both notice boards are currently maintained by the Chair to whom copy may be emailed or hard copies (A5) made available.
- d) There is an advertisement board in Jean's Shop where for a small fee, you can advertise your needs and skills.
- e) Fiveways, the parish magazine, is an excellent source of information and covers the five villages in the parish - St Arvans, Devauden, Itton, Kilgwrrwg and Penterry. It is available by subscription or can be purchased from Jean's Shop.
